

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION SERVICE FOR RESIDENTS OF CITY OF UNLEY



A convenient service provided for residents of the City of Unley to have a safe and responsible collection of Household Hazardous Waste from their home.

Bookings are limited to 15 x properties each month and must be made on-line, via www.unley.sa.gov.au. A Chemical Manifest Form and Agreement to allow Entry to Property (by ToxFree personnel) is required to be completed and returned to Council. A heavy duty storage container (plastic tub) will be provided prior to the collection date – only items in the container will be collected.

We WILL accept

- ✓ Pesticides (including insecticides, herbicides)
- ✓ Pharmaceuticals
- ✓ Interior and Exterior Paint
- ✓ Acids, Alkalis
- ✓ Pool Chemicals
- ✓ Solvents, Flammable liquids
- ✓ Coolant
- ✓ Sealants and Adhesives
- ✓ Aerosols – Oven Cleaner, etc
- ✓ Waste Fuels, vehicle grease
- ✓ Gas Bottles

We WILL NOT accept

- ✓ Fluorescent Tubes & other lamps
- ✓ Smoke Detectors
- ✓ Asbestos
- ✓ Ammunition and Explosives
- ✓ Medical Waste and Sharps
- ✓ Radioactive Materials
- ✓ Tyres
- ✓ E-waste (electrical appliances)

Engine oil, batteries, fluorescent tubes, globes, mobile phones, e-waste (electrical appliances, tv, toaster, vacuum cleaner etc) can be dropped off at Unley Works Depot, 75 King William Road, Unley (M-F 8am-4pm)
