To register for the Unley Community Bus Service, please complete this form and return it in the supplied reply-paid envelope, or phone the Community Bus Coordinator on **8372 5131**.

The Unley Community Bus is a 'door to door' service open to all residents in the City of Unley. The service picks passengers up from their home and transports them to a range of destinations. The service is provided by volunteers and coordinated by City of Unley Staff.

There is no age-based eligibility. Residents must be able to board and disembark the bus independently without assistance.

We ask for a **\$5 donation** on the bus for the round trip.

Your contact details will not be provided to a third party. This information is viewed by staff who require the information for the above purposes.

All passengers are required to register. Whilst we ask for registration it is important to note there is flexibility in the process. This registration will secure passengers a seat on a regular basis, and they only need to call us if they wish to cancel.

The information you provide will be used for the following:

- To contact you in the event of changes to the Community Bus Service
- To contact your listed emergency contact should we not be able to contact you or if you require medical attention while on the bus
- To assist in service evaluation, and
- To keep you updated on information relating to Community Bus Services

PRIVACY AND CONFIDENTIALITY

The City of Unley has a commitment to and will maintain my privacy and confidentiality. Personal information is managed in accordance with the Australian Privacy Principles (APP) and classifies as “personal information” and “sensitive information”. I understand that my information is collected specifically for the purposes of allowing me to access the Community Bus services safely.

I understand that I can access my recorded personal information upon request at any time – and any perceived errors or omissions are corrected on request with verification provided if needed. I understand the City of Unley complies with the Freedom of Information Act 1999.

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF COMMUNITY BUS USE

The Unley Community Bus is a community service promoting respect amongst users, staff and volunteers. Discriminative, insulting, offensive or vulgar behaviour will not be tolerated. Persons not complying may be refused access to the service.

The Unley Community Bus does not accept any liability for personal injury, property damage or loss sustained by a passenger when using the community bus service due to any cause whatsoever. In the event of any emergency an ambulance may be called by Community Bus staff or volunteers and your emergency contact will be notified.

A minimum of two days notice is required for booking a bus service and if passengers need to change their booking, they will contact the Bus Coordinator within a reasonable time to cancel or amend their booking. The Unley Community Bus has the right to cancel bus services or make changes to service delivery. While every effort is made to ensure cancellation does not occur, in some cases this is inevitable and will be at the discretion of the Bus Coordinator.

To be eligible for the Unley Community Bus Service passengers must reside within the City of Unley region. Community Bus Service passengers **MUST** be able to board the bus independently and can carry their own bags. Volunteer bus helpers can assist with bags and walking aids onto the bus. Due to the size of the bus, shopping bags are limited to two per person.

I acknowledge that the City of Unley reserves the right to review or withdraw my access to the Community Bus services should there be a significant decline due in my health, or my behaviour poses a risk to other user, volunteers, or workers.
