### PURPOSE

This briefing will present Elected Members with an overview of the proposed update of Council's Community Land Management Plans (CLMPs). The CLMPs are a legislative requirement of the *Local Government Act 1999* for all community land which is under the care and management of Council.

In the event that Council decides to proceed with the provision of public EV Charging Stations within Council owned car parks, the existing CLMPs must be amended to reflect this. This is the primary reason why the current CLMPs are being considered for an update.

It is also timely to consider this as there have been changes with the presentation of CLMPs in Local Government, and Council's current suite of documents have been reviewed accordingly to reflect contemporary best practice.
