

Small Tree Native Evergreen Flowering: Yes Colour

An evergreen small tree with a stem that is erect, slender and smooth, with typically weeping branches and a lightly textured crown.

Bell-shaped flowers are pale yellow, occurr in clusters during spring; with marble-sized, orange edible berries.

Native of arid and semi-arid areas of Australia, it prefers light to heavy soils in an open, sunny position. It is drought and frost tolerant.
