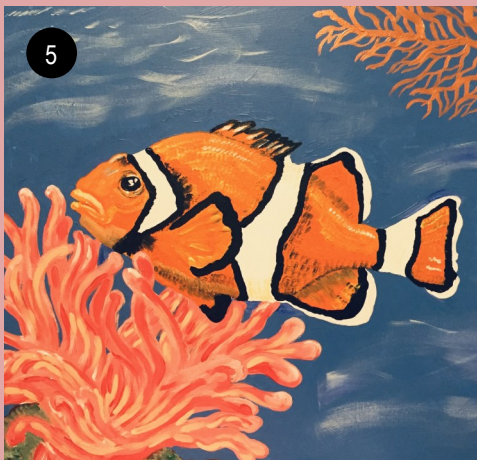

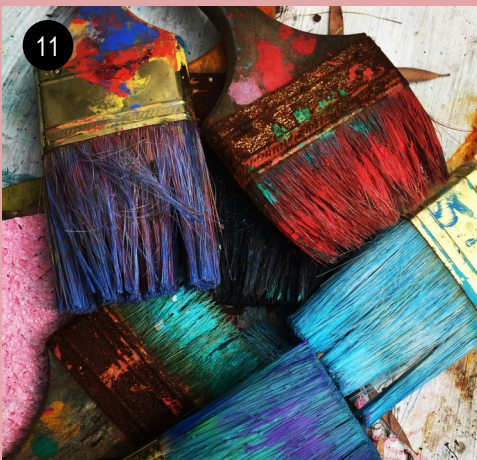


Untethered
