

RULES FOR SAFE POOL USE

Conditions of entry for children under the age of 5 years:

Children **under the age of 5 years** are not admitted into the centre without an appropriate fee paying adult who is prepared to swim

Children **under 5 years** must be accompanied into the centre by a responsible adult over 16 years of age and supervised at arm's reach at all times

Conditions of entry for children under the age of 10 years:

Children **under 10 years** must be accompanied into the centre by a responsible adult over 16 years of age and supervised at all times

Adults responsible for children **under 10 years** must have a clear view of the child at all times with no physical or structural barriers between them and the child while in the aquatics area

Unsupervised children will be removed from the water and placed in a safe area until collected by the parent/guardian

A parent/guardian is regarded as a responsible individual who is over the age of 16.
