### PURPOSE

This workshop provides an opportunity to inform and engage Elected Members on options for a future operating model for Unley's Separate Rate and Business Precinct governance. Specifically, the workshop aims to:

- Explain the current challenges with the existing operating model, including governance risks, volunteer burnout, and limited street-level impact.
- Present strategic options, with a focus on a recommended approach—Establishing a Business Precinct Reference Group.
- Clarify how this option would work in practice, including governance structure, precinct autonomy, allocation of funds, and the role of a Business Precinct Coordinator.
- Seek feedback and direction from Elected Members on the preferred operating model before progressing to a Council Paper in January 2026.

The workshop is designed to ensure Members understand the rationale for change, the pros and cons of different approaches, and the implications for Council resources and precinct stakeholders. It provides an opportunity for questions, discussion, and alignment before a Council report is prepared for consideration.
