PURPOSE

Members will be presented with the newly developed Lead Strategies at the briefing.

The four Lead Strategies have been developed directly from the themes identified within the Community Plan Towards 2050 and form a key component of Council's endorsed Strategic Management Framework. Collectively, the strategies translate the Community Plan's long-term aspirations into strategic direction, priorities and transformative initiatives to guide Council's planning, decision-making and service delivery.

The session will provide an overview of the strategic intent, key priorities and proposed implementation approach for each strategy, including how they align with Council's broader planning framework and organisational priorities.

The presentation will also provide Members with the opportunity to discuss the strategies, seek clarity regarding their development, and provide preliminary feedback prior to future reports or recommendations being presented to Council for consideration.
